Tony Oxendine Sumter, South Carolina

Tony began square dancing in 1972. In 1985, Tony founded Royal Records. He is an Accredited Caller Coach and an accredited member of CALLERLAB. He has served on CALLERLAB's Board, its Executive Board of Governors, and two terms as Chairman of the Board. In 2000, Tony received CALLERLAB's highest award - The Milestone.



Hunter Keller Billings, Montana

Hunter began dancing in early 2004, picking up a microphone six months later eventually becoming the caller for various Billings clubs. In 2008, Hunter revived the club his grandparents formed, the Checkerboard Squares. Hunter has called in 46 states, over 15 countries and on various square dance vacations. In 2010, he began cueing rounds and cues through phase IV. He is a member of CALLERLAB and is a Royal Records Recording Artist.

Larry & Susan Sperry Billings, Montana

Larry and Susan have been dancing together since their high school years. They began cueing and teaching round dancing in the 1980's and continue to be passionate about the program. They have been featured leaders for many state and regional conventions, including Canada and Hawaii. They belong to Round-A-Lab and have received the 35 year service award. Larry and Susan are also active in the Billings Ballroom Club where dancers have become more interested in the round dance program. They offer many varied programs throughout the dance season including social dance classes. The Sperrys are Resident Round Dance Leaders at Towerpoint Resort in Mesa AZ. They teach and cue six sessions weekly for beginners through phase 5 from November through April. They also teach and cue at Sun City, AZ in the Fall and Winter months. They travel to dance, teach and cue at Festivals and events around the Western US during the summer. Dancing has been a huge part of their lives for many years and has given them much pleasure through their travels around the country. They hope to continue to bring new dancers into the activity for vears to come.








Mining City Squares
